TEXTILE AWARDS for FASHION, INTERIORS, COLOUR & PATTERN

The charity Texprint announces the names of the young designers short listed for its prestigious textile awards at its Texprint London event held at the Triangle Building, Chelsea College of Arts.

Following the selection of this year's group of 24 textile designers, chosen by rigorous interview from over 200 put forward by their university tutors across the UK, the annual programme of new designer support begins with the interaction between these newly graduated designers and experienced industry professionals who give their time freely to help mentor the next generation of British-trained creatives.

The four prize winners will be announced 20 September at the main Texprint presentation at Première Vision Designs, Paris, Europe's leading textile design specialty show. Here the designers exhibit their unique textile design collections, meet international buyers and make contacts.

The Texprint Awards Presentation, promoting the talent of British-trained textile designers, takes place in the Texprint 'village' in Hall 5 and is attended by industry guests and press.

The winner of The Woolmark Company Texprint Award will also be announced in Paris in September.
